

# ABOUT FAITH PROMISE GIVING



**“The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into His harvest field.” Matthew 9:37-38**

The need for workers is still as great as when Jesus gave this commandment.

To summarize:

1. We are to **pray** for more workers to be sent into the harvest field.
2. We are to **serve** in the harvest field ourselves.
3. We are to **give** financially so more workers can be sent into the harvest field.

We may have the best intentions to pray, serve and to give, but unless we make a commitment, our good intentions will most likely remain only that. Our Lord is looking for people, who will, by faith, promise to take specific steps of obedience to pray, serve and give. Remember the words of the prophet Samuel “To obey is better than sacrifice.” Making a Faith Promise is an act of obedience, not sacrifice.

## **What a Faith Promise is:**

1. It is a promise to pray and to give a set mission offering each month. At the end of the year, it is time to re-evaluate and find out what He would have you do the next year.  
“Let each one do just as he has purposed in his heart.” (II Corinthians 9:7)
2. It is presenting yourself to God as a living sacrifice (Romans 12:1), so that more people can be reached with the gospel of Jesus. When we make a Faith Promise, we are praying and asking the Lord:
  - Which mission partners do You want me to regularly pray for?
  - Which mission partners do You want me to support financially?
  - How much do You want me to give each partner monthly for the next year?

## **What happens when individual Christians make a Faith Promise?**

1. It releases workers into the harvest fields.
2. It increases the faith of those who make the promise.
3. It helps those who make the promise to align their priorities with God's priorities.

## **How should I use this booklet?**

This booklet is to provide you with some information about various missionaries and ministries that we have identified as partners in our efforts to spread the kingdom of God. Please ask the Lord to guide you and point out to you which missions and ministries He would like for you to support in prayer and through finances over the next year.

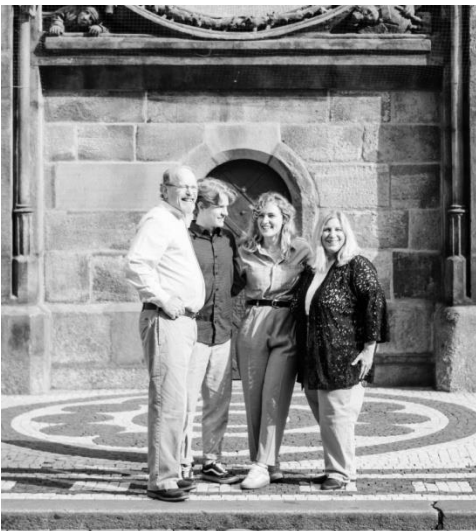

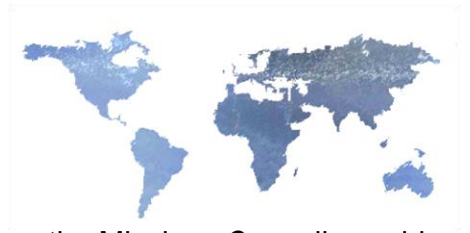
